

# Fire Safety – Overview of Current Fire Legislation and Guidance

## 2-day Course

A two-day workshop reflecting on the guidance and approved documents relating to Fire safety. The workshop is aimed at those involved in the design and development team and those responsible for ensuring compliance with legislation.

The workshop and delivery will incorporate an in-depth analysis of Approved Documents and relevant alternative guidance with particular focus on assessment of plans, design solutions, supportive passive and active fire protection measures and the options available to achieve a safe built environment.

## Programme Aims

To provide delegates with an in-depth understanding regarding the application of legislation in both residential and commercial buildings using a mix of technical delivery and a hands-on approach.

## Programme

- Fire safety – a review of current legislation, highlighting the principles and options available to achieve compliance and the roles and interaction of those involved.
- Review of fire safety on low rise domestic premises. An analysis of various schemes and the application of Approved Documents. This session will consider the options available to providing a safe solution.
- Worked examples of fire safety issues in relation to flats and maisonettes, reviewing layouts and means of escape and examining alternative approaches to fire safety.
- An explanation and analysis of the design consideration in relation to structural fire resistance, and fire development and spread within and between buildings.
- Reviews of fire safety in non-domestic premises, including worked examples and calculations to ensure adequate provisions for means of escape and fire safety issues.

- A review of active fire safety systems, including suppression, detection, alarms and lighting.

The workshops will require delegates to have access to relevant fire safety documents such as Approved Document B vol 1&2 and BS 9999. The two days will involve work both as individuals and in groups.
